not in perfect health But of perfect mind and memory and -  
knowing the mortallitey of my Body Do make and ordain this  
my last will and testament and first as I Gave all my Chil-  
dren thate marry. as much of my Good and Chattles at said time  
of their marrage as I Could well afford It is now my will that  
each of them shall posess no more of my Remaining property than  
one Shilling each excepting my daughter Elizabeth which shall  
have twenty five Dollars as soon as possible after a young horse  
I have and and Desiere to be sold as soon after my Decease as  
possible or in Case I should sell said horse before my Decease and  
Send her what I think Right in that case Shee shall have but  
one shilling -- my Daughter Lydia one shilling -- my one Shilling  
Judey one Shilling Rebbecke one shilling Marey one shilling Ferg-  
bey one Shilling Mattay one shilling I Give to my Sons Jaine  
the tract of land thate said his and is divided from my other

by one Shilling Yetey one Shilling I Give to my Sonne John  
the tract of Land staced out will be divided by my other  
Lands as follows begining where my Line crosses Lowdrey hickes  
Spring Branch and Down said Spring branch to Dunkins Creek thence  
Down said Creek to where a Ditch was Dug and where a fence now stands  
there to cross said Creek and thence on a stright Line to a before-  
orey Corner that stands on my Line between me and benjams pite  
sent and at the corner of a field of mine next sd. pits house  
will my land on the west side of the designated line on bot. sides  
Dunkins Creek shall be his I Bequeath to my other two sons william  
and roger all the remainder of my Lands at their mothers Decease  
who is to have her third where shes chooses and to have the Dis-  
rection of all the plantation till they Come of age and when they  
Inherit said Lands william Shall Give my Daughter Benjams one hun-  
dred Dollars and Roger when he comes to Inherit the whole of his  
Share of sa -t Lands shall Give my Daughter Compece one hundred  
Dollars and I Bequeath to my Daughter peccy one good Bed and Furniture

william Besides the Land my Saddle and Gun I Give to my son  
Roger one Cow and Calf and one good Bed and Furniture when he  
needs them ~ I Bequeath to My Daughter Rachel one Bed and Furni-  
ture and one Cow and Calf when shee marrys or Is come of age  
I Bequeath to my Daughter Banney one Bed and one Cow and Calf  
I Bequeath to My Daughter Genney one good Bed and Furniture  
with one Cow and Calf when shee marrys or is of age all my  
Books at their mothers Decease I Desire may be equilley Divided  
Betwee my two youngest sons william and Roger I Give and Bequeath  
all the Remainder of my Goods and Chattles of every kind to my  
wife Bexey with care and managment of the pantation till my two  
youngest sons or either of them comes to age or marrys and then  
If shee is alive she must Chus her thirds and In case my wife  
Bexey should marrey my will is that that the man shee marrys Shall  
have no power to Dispose of anything I Leave nor shall he Correct  
aney of my Children but Leave them with all I Leave to my wifes  
Care and correction my will is the Land shall not be Cleard nor

the corner cut away more than is sufficient to Raise the Fences  
and lay up the stones in my garden and the garden of my wife

wife the whole of my Land be equeley Divided between my said two  
sons William and Roger and lastly I constitute and my Oath

my wife Bezy the sole Executor of this my Last will and testament

this Day of December in the year of our Lord 1818 and witness

whereof I have hereunto Subscribed my name Roger Brown
