2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my son James McCrada five dollars only having previously provided for him

3<sup>rd</sup> I give Jane McCrady, Margaret McCrada, and Caroline McCrada

Children of my son John McCrada One dollar each

4<sup>th</sup> I give to my beloved wife Mary McCrady all my estate both real

and personal not heretofore disposed of to her for and during the

term of her natural life for her support, and after her decease

I give the same to my Son Robert Carter McCrada to him his heirs

and assigns forever

And lastly I constitute and appoint my said wife Executrix and my

Son Robert Carter McCrada Executor of this my last will and testa-

ment hereby revoking all other former Wills and testaments. In
