Know all Men by these presents, that I Ann Cox of the State And district Aforesaid, do Make this instrument My last Will And testament therefore I give And Bequeath to My Daughter Sarah- R. Brown two Negroes, one Man, and one woman, (Namely) Charles and Sene, I give Said Negroes And there increase to her, Sarah R. Brown during her natural lifetime, And at her death to her lawful Children, And if She has no Issue, at her death  $\frac{d}{2}$ , negroes and there increase to be divided between My two Sons, Jeremiah J. J. Brown And George B. Cox - also one Bed Stid, Bed and furniture,--

I give And bequeath to My Son Jeremiah J. J. Brown two Negroes, one woman & there increas and one Boy (Namely Grace and Simon) Also two hundred Acres Land being part of the tract I now live on, Say to be run off the back line near Burches Mill Creek, to have And to hold the  $\frac{d}{2}$ , Negroes And there increase, also the  $\frac{d}{2}$  piece of Land during his natural life time, And at his death to his lawful Children, And if he has no Children to be divided between My Daughter Sarah R. Brown and My Son George B. Cox also one Bed Stid Bed and furniture - I give And bequeath to my Son George B - Cox two negroes, one Man and one Girl (Namely Isaac and Eleanor and there increase, also the balance of the Tract of Land which I live on, the Houses included, to have and to hold the Said Negroes and there increase and Said tract of Land during his natural lifetime at his death to his lawful Children and if he dies without Children,  $\frac{d}{2}$  Negroes and there increase And Said tract of Land, to be Equely divided between My Daughter Sarah R. Brown And My Son Jeremiah J. J- Brown - Also one Bed Stid Bed And furniture --

As regards My house hold and Kitchen Furniture, not above given off, My Stock of Cattle, Horses, and Hogs, the crop that is on the plantation at my Death, Must be Sold by My Executors (except my Gig Horse and Gig, which I Give to my Daughter Sarah R. Brown, And the proceeds thereof with the Amount of Note And accounts My debts are to be Settle therefrom And the Balance Equely divided Among My Children, (Namely, Sarah R. Brown, Jeremiah J. J. Brown and George B. Cox --
