ARCHIBALD KERBY

South Carolina) In the Name of God, amen I, Archibald. Kerby of the state
 Marion District) and. district afores^d. being indisposed in body but in perfect
 mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing
 that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last
 will and testament and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath
 pleased. God to blefs me with in this life I give demise and dispose of in the
 following manner and form first of all that my debts be paid out of my prop-
 erty by my executors hereafter named secondly I give unto my beloved wife
 Mary. Kerby two hundred and fifty acres of Land Contain^{ng} the plantations and
 houses on s. Land. beging on lightwood stake on the south west. side of the
 great road leading from Marlborough. Courthouse to Marion Court-house and Run-
 ing out from road towards the great .P.D. river to branch to corner on pine
 then up s.^d branch to corner on pine then across. s.^d branch to corner on pine
 then a strait line to cool spring branch and across s^d branch to corner on
 pine p.^f stake thence a strait course back to the s.^d road to corner on large
 pine on the s. w. side of s.^d road made for Jarret moonenham and. my self then
 down s.^d road to first. mentioned corner also all my household and Kitchen
 furniture also one mare her choice of the two I now have also two cows and
 their calves her choice during her natural life and after her decease the land
 given to my wife to be then by this will the property of charles Kerby Jun^r
 son of Charles Kerby sen.^r thirdly I give unto my beloved son charls Kerby
 ten dollars to be paid by my Executors fourthly I give unto Archibald Kerby^{Sen}
 son of charls Kerby two hundred acres of Land. the same being more or less
 begining on pine corner p.^f stake on the. S. W. side of cool spring branch
 at the same corner for my wife and runing down s.^d branch on the west. side
 to corner on black gum p.^f stake in s.^d branch then up towards the gret peeson
 to ditch made by Christopher dew deest to Corner on stake p^f bay tree in the
 side of s.^d ditch then up and along the side of s. ditch to Corner on pine then
 out towards catfis swamp or bay to corner on pine p.^f stake on my mill branch
 on. N. W. side then up s.^d branch to corner on large pine made for jarrit moonen^{ham}
 then out to Road to corner on lage pine made for jarrit Moonenham and my wife
 then to first.mentioned. corner the above mentioned Land. I give my wife if
 she should depart this life before the above named Charles Kerby be of the age

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of twenty one years my Executors. to Rent the s. Land and; to divide the^d and house
 profits arising from the Rents after pay. himself or selves for services
 Equally Between Charles Kerby sen.^F and his lawful heirs untill the s. Charles.^d
 be twenty one years of age and if the s. Charles Kerby Jr. should-decease
 before he becomes to be twenty one years of age the Land wiled to him to be.
 Rented by my executors or their assigns or Executors the term of twenty five
 years after his decease and divided as above directed also. if Archibald
 Kerby ju.^F should depart this life before he becomes to the age of twenty one
 years the above named land, to be rented the term of twenty five years also.
 the above named two hundred acres of Land which I give in this my last will
 out to Arch^d Kerby jr
 and testam^t to be Rented untill he becomes to be twenty one years of age
 and all profits arising by any Rents. from the same to be Equally divided be-
 tween Charles Kerby sen-^F and. his lawful heirs by my Executors hereafter named
 Whereas. I constitute make and ordain Isham Watson and. Elias Addams Jun.^F the
 sole Executors of this my last. will and testament and I do hereby utterly
 disallow Revoke and dsannull all and everry other former testamen or Wills
 heretofore by me made acknowledging this to be my last will and testament In-
 witness whereof I set my hand and seal this twelfth day of May in the year of
 our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Eight. and in the sixty second
 year of Americas Independancy--
