

WILL OF

BRYANT JONES

In the name of God Amen

I Bryan Jones of the state of South Carolina and District of Marion being weak of body but of sound mind and memory calling to mind the uncertainty of life do make ordain and appoint this my last will and testament hereby revoking annulling and disallowing all former wills by me made

In the first place it is my will and desire that my body receive decent Christian burial and that the expenses thereof be paid by my executors hereafter to be named out of my estate and as touching what worldly property I may have at the time of my death I do hereby dispose of in manner and form following that is to say In the first place I give and bequeath to my youngest son James A Jones my negro boy child Frank Floras child now about four months old to be his and at his disposal forever In the next place it is my will and desire that all my property of every description real and personal remain upon my plantation and that my executors hereafter to be named have the entire controle thereof and shall manage the same according to their discretion to the best advantage for the benefit of my wife and children and that my beloved wife Elisabeth Jones and my three sons Henry, Frederic and James A Jones remain upon my plantation and be supported from the proceeds thereof until my son James A shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years and that my three sons receive a reasonable allowance for education and other reasonable expenses -

When my son James shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years it is then my will and desire that my beloved wife Elisabeth Jones should have all my land containing one thousand acres more or less my three negroes nee Flora and Kitty and four cows and calves five head of sheep ten head of hogs and all my household and kitchen furniture during the term of her natural life and then at her death to be equally divided among my lawful heirs share and share alike and it is my desire that all the valance of my property except what has been loaned to my wife should when my said son James A ~~arrive~~ arrive at the age of twenty one be equally divided between my three daughters Elisabeth Nancy and Mary my three sons Henry Frederic and James A. only that my son James A is to have the boy Frank over and above his equal share with my other children and I do

herby constitute nominate and appoint my trusty and wole beloved soninlaw James Watson and my son Frederic Jones Executors to this my last wile and testament with full power and lawful authority to carry out the provision of this my last will and testament - it is my wile that my soninlaw James Watson should at the division of my property account to my other heirs for a negre boy I have heretofre given him

I the afore named Bryan Jones do hereby acknowlede and declare the above to be my last will and testament hereby revoking ale former wills by me made in witnefs where of I have herunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal in the presence of the subscribing witnefses this eleventh day of august in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine and in the seventy third year of the independance of the united states of america
