South Carolina) In the Name of God Amen. I Daniel M^cInnis of this State
 Marion District) and District being of sound and disposing mind and judgment knowing that all men must die. and after death must answer for their acts on earth at the great judgement which is in the future to be, all of which I do steadfastly believe in Being prompted to these reflections from the fact of my long and continued low state of Health feeling that before long I must be done with all that pertains to me on earth. I do therefore constitute this and declare it to be my last Will & Testament to be. as follows, viz. I give and bequeath to my beloved son James P. M^cInnis and the lawful heirs of his body, if he dies leaving any such heirs. and ^{if he} does not leave any such heirs for them to revert back to my two daughters Margaret & Jettiner M^cInnis and the heirs of their body, My two negroes. Clea & Giles and their increase. I also give to my son James P. M^cInnis one young mare, named Kit, Two cows & yearlings, including the one he now has in possession, and my Black shop & wood shop Tools.

I give and bequeath to my two daughters Margaret & Jettiner M^cInnis, or the survivor if either of them should die leaving no heir from her body, but should they both have heirs from their body to said bodily heirs equally. all my Lands. Houses. Tenements & free hold ^{estate} being the same on which I now live lying on both sides of Little Pee Dee river supposed to be five hundred acres the same being more or less. I also give to my Two daughters Margaret & Jettiner all my household and kitchen furniture. Plantation and farming Tools. cart. and Buggy. Two work creatures. Twelve head of cattle (including cow & calf as one) as much of my stock of Hogs as they may need. my stock of sheep my. crop provinder & provisions so much of it as they may need for their years support.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret M^cInnis and the heirs of her body if she dies leaving such heirs but if she dies leaving no such heirs to her sister Jettiner M^cInnis and the heirs of her body. my three negroes viz Ann. Harriet and Charles & their increase.

I Give and bequeath to my daughter Jettiner M^cInnis and the heirs of her body if she dies leaving such heirs but if she dies leaving no such heirs to

her sister Margaret M^cInnis and the heirs of her body. My three negroes viz Lydia, Wealy and July and their increase. And it is my wish & desire that my negro boy Harry, one waggon one Mule and all other of property not being disposed of in the foregoing bequest. I wish sold and proceeds applied in assisting my other means to pay just debts and should be a surplus after meeting all such contingences for it to be equally divided between my three children. James P. Margaret & Jostiner and further more I constitute and appoint my two friends Neill M^cKimmon & Robert C. Hamer Trustees to superintend and guard that part of the foregoing bequest as I have made it to my two daughters Margaret M^cInnis & Jostiner M^cInnis. And farther more nominate & appoint my said friends Neill M^cKimmon and Robert C. Hamer the lawful and true officers to settle my estate and the foregoing bequests. In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal. This the fourteenth day of November A. D. one thousand eight hundred and forty nine.
