I also give to my Two dayghters Hargaret & Jestiner all my household and kitchen furnature. Plantation and farming Tools, eart. and Buggy. Two work creatures. Twelve head of eattle (including now & ealf as one) as much of my stock of Hogs as they may need. my stock of sheep my, crep provinder & provisions so much of it as they may need for their years support.
