ELIAS BARNES

In the name of God Amen., I, Elias Barnes, do make this my last will and Testament. in the first place, I desire that all my Just debts, and funeral expenses, be fully paid.--, after which, all that may be left, it is my will that it shall belong to the Children of my Nephew, Joel Barnes., share and share alike - my little property consists of Cattle, hogs, and a few debts, which my Executor will Collect as soon after, my death, as he conveniently can.,. and with it pay my said debts.

Lastly I nominate Constitute and appoint my Nephew, Joel Barnes Executor of this my last Will and testament,

day of June A. D. 1835. and in the fifty
Ninth year of american Independence.
