Pourthly I give and bequenth to my sens James Gaddy Hardy Gaddy Allen Gaddy my daughter Hansy Hays my Son Siles Gaddy and my daughter Hary Stackhouse the other Six eighths left one hundred to be equally divided energet them at ITHAMAR GADDY'S WILL PAGE &

the death of my wife Charity and if my they themselves cannot divide that they choose five disinterested men to divide for them or to call the said property and divide the proceeds as a majority may elect

And Should my wife not choose to Keep all the property during her life she can give it up to my executors bereafter maned and they shall enuse it to be devided amongto my heirs according to the tenor of the forgoing Arcticles be it much or Little all she may choose so to give up And lastly I constitute and ordain my some Hardy Gaddy and Allen Gaddy my executors to this my last will and Testament To which I set my hand and seal on the day and in the year first above written constituting and ordaining it my last will and Testament and reveking all others
