In the name of God Amen, I James Hoody of Marion Destrict and State aforesaid finding my bodily health failing but of sound mind and memory. (blefsed be God) Do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following. First I order my body to be decently buried at the descretion of my mater Herein after named, and all my just debte be fully satisfied out of the whole of My Retate Item I will and bequeth to My Daughter Mary Me Daniel one eow and salf to her and the Ifoue of her body forever Item I will & bequeth to my Daughter Eliza Williams the two cows that She has had, with their increase, to her and the Ifour of her body forever Item I will and bequeth to my two single Daughtrs Caroline & Sophia each two cows & calves to them and the lawfull lique of their bodys forever Item It is my will that all my Negro property with the balance of my perisable property not named above, be Kept on the plantation for the use and benefit of My Wife and unmarried Children until my youngest Surviveing Child somes to the age of twenty one years and then my Negro property be equally divided between my wife and all my Children. Item I will and bequenth, that, My Wife have the use of my dwelling house and fifty acres of Land adjoining during her natural life Item I will and bequeath to my some when the youngest comes to the age of twenty one all of my Lands (including that portion given to My Wife to be thiere at her death) Item I Will and bequeath to My wife & sons all the Morses Hogs & cattle remaining on the plantation when my youngest child comes to the age of twenty one years Item It/my will that the Negree falling to the Share of my sife at her death be divided equally between my Children, Item It is my will that all the property falling to the separate Shares of each of My Daughters (viz) Mary Maniel, Elener, Wilkons, Elisa Hilliams Martha Byham Caroline Moody, & Sophia Moody be given to them à the lauful Ifoue of their bodys forever Lastly I constitute and appoint T Wilson Executor of this My last Will and Testament and I do hereby disallow, disamual and reveks all and every other Tostament, Will, Legacy, and bequeast, or Empeutors by me heretofore mused, willed, and Bequeathed; Ratifing, and confirming this and no other to be my last will, and Testament, in witness whereof I have here unto Set my hand and Seal this minth of June
