Item "2 it is my will that my bloved wife to have all the Stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep Goats and Hogs, also all the household and Kitchen furniture, and the growing Crop of Corn and Cotton, after all of my debts is paid, An at her death all Stock house hold and Kitchen furniture it is my will for it to be equally divided between my Children namely, Morris, W- Maryan Hushir-son and Hilda T. Hatchel to there use forever

Item "3. I give and bequeath after the death of my beloved wife, to my So H T. Hatchel the land I now lives on to him during his natural life time and after his death, to be equally divided Among his lawful Children if he has any At his death And if he dies without Any, then the land to be equally divided among all of my Grand children

Item "4 I do hereby appoint my wife as my Executrix
