 Marion District) In the name of God Amen, I John Richardson of the State
 and District aforesaid being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind
 and memory blefsed be Almighty God for the Same - do make and publish this
 my last will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say)
 First after paying all my just debts and funeral expences I give and bequeath
 unto my beloved wife Thamer Richardson Two negroes named June and Lisett
 One Horse Ten Cows and Calves and One bed and furniture I do also give
 and bequeath unto my eldest son William F. Richardson Four negroes named
 Sall Eliza Frank and Caswell I do also give and bequeath unto my Son
 Valentine Richardson one negree fellow named Abraham I do also give and be-
 queath unto my Son Andrew I Richardson Eight negroes named Baccus Mary
 Daniel Peter Friday Binah Cherety And Silvey one Horse Ten Cows and calves
 One bed and furniture and the clock Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved
 daughter Martha Leggett the wife of David Leggett Two negroes named Rachel
 and Joe Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Charlette Leggett
 wife of Jesse Leggett one negree man named John also I give and bequeath unto
 my beloved daughter Emaline Richardson Six negroes named Tom Candie Henry
 Ann Jack and little Tom one Horse Ten cows and calves one bed and furniture
 & one large looking glafe-- also I will and order that the Two negroes and
 their issue that I have herein bequeathed unto my beloved wife be sold at
 her death and the money equalley divided among all of my children that is
 now alive or if any of them Should be dead then then unto their children rep-
 resenting their Parent drawing one Share Should any of my children that is
 now unmarried die without leaving any lawful children then it is my will and
 I do herein order that all the negroes and their encrease that I have herein
 bequeathed unto them be equally devided among my children that is now alive
 or if any of them should be dead then unto their children representing their
 Parent drawing one Share Also it is my will and order that all my household
 and Kitchen furniture plantation tools stock of Hogs and sheep and all the
 stock of provision that may be on the plantation at my death shall remaine
 on the plantation with my son Andrew I Richardson Emaline Richardson and my

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wife for their use and benefit when my wife and my daughter Emaline sees proper to remove from living with my son Andrew I then I do herein give and bequeath unto my son Andrew I Richardson all the above named household and Kitchen furniture Stocks of Hogs and Sheep and plantation tools also I will and order that all my lands that I have not otherwise given away Consisting of Eight Tracts with all the residue of my Horses and cattle to be sold and the money arising therefrom together with all my ready money bonds notes and accounts to be equally divided among my legal heirs It is my wish that my Two old negroes Friday and Binah be well used and taken good care of while they live I do give and bequeath them the said Two old negroes unto my Two Sons William F Richardson and Valentine Richardson when I do hereby Appoint joint executors to this my last will and Testament and hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this Eleventh day of November in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and forty one and Sixty Sixth of American Independence
