2 As to my worldly possessions, I will and bequeath all that I possess to my loving wife Mary A. Monite, after first paying all my just and lawful debts, to be used in manner and form as follows Vis - For Said wife Mary to take and keep the said pofsefsions, Consisting of houses and lands Negroes, Stock of horses, Cattle, hogs and Sheep, household and other furniture, tools and all other preperty whatsoever under her Controle and management, to be kept together on the plantation and the proffits of the Same to be applied to her use, the use of the plantation and to the raising and educating of my Children, and at the time that each of my Children becomes of Age or So Soon thereafter as said child may wish, for her my loving wife Mary to set apart a portion of land one horse, one Gan, and two or three magroes and such other property as she may think proper, to be appraised and delivered to one so claiming to his use and benefit. And after the death of my loving wife for all the remainder of property to be equally- divided (Counting first the amount that each received according to appraisement when he became of age) between my Children, And I do hereby appoint my loving wife Mary A Mewhite and my Son G. W. M'White Executrix and Executor of this my last will and Testament, I witness whereof I do hereunto Set my hand & seal this 30
