South Carolina      I Owen Jackson of the State and Dist above mentioned do  
 Marion District      make this my last Will and Testament making void all  
 former Wills by me at any time made

1<sup>st</sup> It is my desire that my body shall be buried in a christain like manner  
 and that funeral and ale other of my Just Debts shall be paid

2<sup>nd</sup> It is my desire that my wife Dilly and my Daughter Elisabeth shall Jointly  
 have the use of the following property during their natural life and that  
 the survivor of the other shale have the Exclusive right of said property  
 during her natural life The Tract of Land on which I now live with Two Hun-  
 dred Acres to be cut off from my tract of Land called the Bay place, next ad-  
 joining the Land on which I now live together with all the stock of Horses  
 Hogs cattle and Sheep that I shall not hereafter give away with all the farm-  
 ing Tools Household and Kitchen furniture

3<sup>rd</sup> It is my Wish that my son Irvin shall have the Tract of Land called  
 the Grafay Bay Tract One Horse Bridle and Saddle and at the Death of my wife  
 Dilly and Daughter Elisabeth he shale have all the Lands that I have given  
 to them

4<sup>th</sup>  
 It is my desire that the balance of the Land called the Bay Land Shall  
 be Equally divided between my following named Children Ann.Harriet Martha  
 Sarah Ann and lawfull Heirs of the body of my Daughter Lucinda. If she should  
 never have lawfull Issue to live then that that would be theirs to be Equally  
 divided between my four children mentioned under this Head

I do nominate and Constitute Lisias Stackhouse and my Son Irvin Jackson as  
 Executors to this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and Seal this October 20<sup>th</sup> Eighteen Hundred and forty nine  
 Signed in the presence of us who are witnesses      his  
 to the same at the request of the Testator and      Owen X Jackson  
 in presence of each other and in presence of      mark  
 the Testator
