I Roger Sorden of the District and State aforesaid, of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding, to make and ordain the following as my last will and testament

- I I give and devise the land whereon I live, containing (by a resurvey of Levi Legate certified the 7th May 1841) four hundred and seventy seven acres also my River Lands to my son Alped Bloomfield Gordon and my daughter Rectina Jame Priestley Levallan equally to be divided between them, to them their heirs and afsigns forever.
- 2 To my two grand sone Benjamin Franklin Luallan & Jefse Burkes Luallan I give and bequenth I give and bequenth the following negroes To wit. Boston venus Candace Laura Lisette Jefferson and James equally to be divided between them to them their heirs & afsigns forever.
- 3 All my other negroes, & their future increase, all the rest and residue of my Retate of whatsoever description which I may have or own, at the time of my decease, horses makes cattle hogs, sheep household & kitchen furniture, cotten corn provisions of all Kinds moneys & choses in action of all Kinds, I give and bequeath in equal parts to my son Alped Bleomfield Gordon & my daughter Rectina Jame Priestly Lumlian to them their heirs & afsigns forever.
- 4. It is my will that if there should be any natural increase enong the negroes given to my two grand sons before my death, that such natural increase should go to them as a part of their legacy.
- 5 It is my will that in the event that my son Alped Bleomfield Gordon should die before my decease, that the devise & legacy herein given to him Should not lapse, but in that Event I give & bequeath the lands & personal Estate herein given to him, to the children he may leave, & if he leaves no children them I give devise & bequeath said lands & personal Estate to my grand sons in equal parts to them their heirs & afsigns forever
- \$ It is also my wile that in the event that my daughter Rectina J. P. Luallan Should depart this life before my decease, the device & legacy herein given to her Should not on that account lapse, but in that Event I give device & bequenth the said land & personal Estate herein given to my said daughter, to my two grand Sone Benjamin F. Luallan & Jefse B. Luallan & their heirs & afsigns

forever .
