Marion District } in the name of God Amen I Solomon Owens of
the State and district aforesaid wishing my buisness arranged and settled to
my mind and now being in health and of sound mind and memory and calling to
mind the mortality of my body Knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die do now make constitute and ordain this my last will and testament in
manner and form followeng I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of
Almighty God who give it and my body to its Mother dust to be buried in a
christian manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at
the resurrection of the dead I shall receive the same again by the almighty
power of God and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to
blesse me with in this life I I dispose as follows viz ——————
1st Item I give and leam unto my beloved Wife Annes Owens the followeng
property on the conditions that She excepts of it as her full part of my Es-
tate that is to say I give and bequeath unto her one horse and chair and two
cows and calves and I loan unto the said Annes dureng her widowhood and while
she remains on the primestes hereafter mentioned for her support and the
support and education of my minor children the followeng property viz the
lower half of the plantation on which I now live and also the followeng ne-
groes. Jerry Lasy Rose Sam Emanuel Sigh Sucky and Mary also my house hold
and kitchen furniture plantation tools of every ~~kind~~ ^{sort} my discription and my
stock of ale kinds viz horses males cattle Hogs & sheep untell my minor heires
respectively comes of age or marry and then it is my request that they Should
individually receive the portion of my ~~prop~~ ^{prop}erty hereafter detailed unto
them I also request that my executors tho I leave it disrekenary with them
should continue the ballance of the negroes on the plantation for the above
mentioned purposes untill the heir that it may belong to comes of age or
maries then to be given unto him or her
2nd Item I had given to my son Alix D G Owens my lower tract of land a part of
differant tracts by deeds containing four hundred and —— acres more or less
having such form as the plat drawn by L Leggett represents with the exceptions
made in the deed which I Still claim for my two other sons but I have pur-

cheased it back from him with the intention of leaveng it to my Son David--- I have already given him the Said Alexander four negroes pompy Ferreby anthony and John and I give and bequeth into him a negro named Frank

3rd Itim I give and bequeth unto my Son David G Owens six negroes named

Simon peter & Hannah Jenny and her two Children Telatha & Henry with there increase three cows and calves and six head of sheep and one yoke of oxen and cart

4th Itim I give and bequeth unto my Son William Joseph Owens the lower half of the plantation on which I now live at the marrage death or removal of his step mother from the primises also one half of all the other lands that I may die possessed of in marion District also six negroes named James Debby Elly Milly and hir two children Jane & Willes and there increase and one horse one yoke of oxen one cart and three cows & calves & six head of Sheep

5 Item I give and bequeth unto my son Edward B Owens by marrage contract deed of gift and by this my last will and testament the fellowing property viz the upper half of the plantation I now live on and One half of all the lands that I may die posseed of in marion Destrict also six negroes named Sucky Laundry Jeanch phobby nancy and Madison and there increase One horse one yoke of oxen and cart three Cows and calves and six head of Sheep

6th Itim I give and bequeth unto my Daughter Elisabeth I Clark the following negroes and there increase duaring the natural life viz Primus Pinder Dimch Rebecc & Julian and at her death the right of Said negroes and there increase to be fully vested in her lawfull children should she die and leave no lawfull issue then the Said negroes and there increase to return and be considered part of my Estate and disposed of in the same maner as the above negroes that I have leand to my Wife also I give and bequeth to her three cows and calves and Six head of sheep

7th Itim I give and bequeth unto my daughter Cady G Owens the use of the following negroes and there increase during her natural life viz Jefferson Lisset pompy Nancy Abram and Caroline and at her death the right of Said negroes and there increase to be fully vested in her children Should She die and leave no lawfull issue then the Said negroes and there increase to return and be considered part of my Estate and disposed of in the Same maner as the above ne-

grees that I have loan to my wife also I give and bequeath unto her three Cows & calves and one head of Sheep

8th Item it is my will and desire that ~~my~~ executors at the death or marriage of my wife Annes or her removal from the primitis take all the personal property and its increase that were lone to my wife and all the property that I may be possefed of at my death and not have disposed of and divide it as equally as they can allowing an equal share to each of my children or to there - - - - - if any Should be dead leaving lawfull issue and let them draw there part my two daughters Share to be under the same restrictions as the other property I have left them

9th Item I also desire that my servant Peter who is now ~~advancing~~ ^{wances} in years and haveng faithfully Served me Should have his own time & labour and that my executors Should not admit of his being Sold or in any maner claimed by any of my heirs but he will remain on the plantation and have charge of the Stock I also have one other negro Rebeca she who haveng born thirteen children I request that she may have the same chance she now has and work for herself and children I for several year having allowed her this liblerty and that she be not Sold or Claimed as in the case of Peter above

11th Item I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Alex D G Owens Levi Carroll David Edwards and Richard Edwards the Executors of this my last will and testament and I do furthermore disallow and all other wills by me heretofore made in witness whereof I have now to Set my hand & seal this 25 day of April - A D - 1835 in the 69th of American independance
