ion court house. also one other Lot number twenty three with all my house
hold & kitchen furniture. with my horse & chear & harnes

2.. Imprimis I give & Bequeath unto my friend John Colson to him & his
heire forever one Lot number twenty five near Marion Court house. also all my
notes & due bills and monies that the Sheriff shall or may have in his hand
at the day of my death, and also the rear rent that shall be due on the a-
bove mentioned lots in the city of Charleston Lastly I nominate constitute
& appoint Samuel Cooper Esquire Thomas Harllee Esquire ~~and~~ Thomas Godbold
Esquire & John Colson Executors of this my Last will & testament revoking
& disannulling all other wills & testaments by me heretofore made ~~and~~ ~~fulfilling~~

thirty second year of american independence
