 unto my Grandson Gilbert Warren McKay. one Negro Boy William. I then
 give and bequeath into my Grand Daughter Flora Ann McKay ~~the~~ Hector McKay
 Daughter. one Negro Girl named Sarah. also Two Hundred Dollars in Cash. and
 one bed and furniture I also give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Flora
 Ann McKay (John McKay's Daughter) one bed and furniture.
 I then give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Bethea Two Dollars I then
 give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Flora Jane Bethea. one Bed and Fur-
 niture I then give and bequeath unto my son Archie McKay Two Dollars I then
 give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Jane McKay. one Bed and
 furniture I then give and bequeath unto my niece Barbara McAllister one fea-
 ther Bed a Double Blanket and Two Cows & calves, My wife is then that all
 the Balance of my Property be Equally Divided between John McKay Jane Be-
 thea Archie McKay & Flora Ann McKay (Hector's Daughter. and lastly I constitute
 and appoint my beloved sons John McKay & Archie McKay Executors to this my
 last will and Testament.. In witness whereof I hereto set my hand and seal
 this 1st day of Oct in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred &
 thirty Two. & in the fifty Six & Seventh of the Independence of the United
 States of America
