mend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body recom-
mend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion
of my Executor nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall re-
ceive the same again by the mighty power of God And as touching such worldly
state wherewith it has pleased God to bleſs me in this life I give demise
and dispose of the same in the following manner and form First I give all
my estate both real and personal to the lawful heirs of Philip and Martha
McBride in Ireland Uster Province Onagh County near Dicmore to be equally
divided Share and Share alike Also I constitute make and ordain my trusty
friends Thomas Harilee Trietrum Bethea and Bryant H Bafs my Executors to
this my last Will and testament I now make a statement where all my prop-
erty may be found One negro man Frank hired to B H Bafs one negro woman hired
to Ephraim L Henagan Three hundred acres of land where Daniel Morrison now
lives also One hundred acres of land near the Three Creeks where Mrs Wilks
now lives also Six negroes in the State of Mississipi in the posſeſſion of
William Long Seven hundred Dollars worth of Receipts in the hands of William
Bethea Sem All the above stated property I desire my Executors to sell to
the best advantage and the moneys arising therefrom to be Applyd as above di-
rected to my friends in Ireland Revoking all other former wills do make and
ordain this to be my last Will and testament 7th day of April 1834 Signed
