In the name of god amen I Jacob Yelventon of the State of South Carolina in Liberty County Being very sick and weak in Body But of sound mind ~~and~~ thanks be given unto god Calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that its is appointed for all men Once to die do make and ordain this my Last will and Testement that is to say principally and first of all I give and Recoomend my Soul into the hand of almighty god that gave it and my Body I Recoomend to Earth to Be Buried in a decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall Receive the same again By the mighty Power of god and as touching such worldly estate where with it hath pleased god to blefs me in this Life I give devise and Dispofo of the Same in the following manner and form First I give and Beueath to my Beloved Son Shaderick yelventon one young Bay mare now in the pursession of Joseph Page also I give to my Beloved Son Gedian yelvento all the money I have By me and Due to me and two three year old Stears and all my wareing Cloths also I Give to my Beloved Son Zado yelventon one feather Bed and all the furnetur to it Belonging and all my Carpanders tools and one gang of hogs Containing 2 sows and 11 pigs and 6 yearold and one grine Stone and three quart Basons also give and Lend to my Beloved Dafter Unity Cr on all my Land During her Life and then to her Dafter Nady Green and her ares lawfully Begoten of her Body and if She Should Dy with out any heir it is to Return to my son Zadoo yelventon and his heirs also I give to my Dafter unity Green one one feather bed and furnetur and all the Re-remaining part of my Hogs and all my Sheep that is in the gear of Cear of thomas ard and all the Cattle in the Cear of John Barfoot also my Rideing mare Saddle and Bridle and if with fould now the Colt is to Bee my Gransons Gidian yelventons also I give to my Dafter unity Green two Cows and Calves of my home Stock and all the Remaining part of my house hould goods and all my working tools and all the Remaining part of my Cattle I give to my Beloved Dafter Reese Wilkeson also I give to my Granson Jesse yelventon that Stock of Sheep in the hand of John Barfoot also
