cretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty
power of God And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith
it has pleased God to blefs me. with in this life I give de-
mise and dispose of the same in the following manner & form.
First I. give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Tart One
negro Boy named Dick One other negroe Boy named Peter. one
negroe woman named Aney & a Small Stock of Cattle the Negroes
and Cattle before mentioned is now in the pofsefsion. of my
Daughter ~~Elizabeth Tart~~ I also give to my will beloved Daugh-
ter Elizabeth Tart two other negroes. One woman named Befas. and
one girl named Deby. Also I give to well beloved Daughter Char-
ity Porter one negroe one negroe Woman named Sally one negroe
Boy named Luke one Girl named Ginne and one old Negro woman
named Mollie Also I give to my well beloved Daughter Martha
Gasque one negroe woman named Patt One Negroe boy named Simon
& one negroe man named Joe. Also I give and bequeath to my
well beloved son James Crawford one negroe man. Quash One
negro woman named Sall One negro Girl named Mary One negro Boy
named Bill and the Plantation and tract of land situate at Cas-
huaway Ferry on Pee Dee Also I give to my well beloved Daughter
Sally Crawford One negroe Men. named Ben. One negroe woman named
Esther and her three children Manuel David & Milla Also I give
to my will beloved daughter Nancy Crawford one negroe man named

Borough. One negroe woman named Lilah & her two children Frank & Nell Also I give to to my well beloved daughter Sarah Ann Crawford one negroe man named Pirce one negroe woman named Aley one negro boy named Pirce one negro boy named Stephen & one negro boy named Tim Also I give the ballance of my negrees that is not already named in my Will to be equally divided amongst my children share and share alike Also I give and bequeath to my three youngest daughters Sally Crawford Nancy Crawford & Sarah Ann Crawford the Plantation and tract of land which I now reside one Catfish to be equally divided amongst them the. Ballance of my lands to be equally divided amongst. the rest of my surviving children. Also I. give all the remaining part of my property that I may be pofsefssed of at the time of my decease to be equally divided amongst my Heirs share and share alike I likewise constitute make and ordain my well beloved son. James Crawford the sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills Legacies bequests and. Executors by me in any wise before named willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal Seventeenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Sixteen and in the forty first year. of the Independence of the United States of America Signed Sealed published pronounced and declared by the said James Crawford Senior as his last Will and testament in presence of us ^{who} in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names
