equally divided between my wife Elisabeths Children I also give and bequeath
unto my said children by my said wife all that part of her Estate at her
death or marriage to be equally divided between them I also bequeath to my
beloved wife Elizabeth the lands plantation and house also one horse bridle
and Saddle her lifetime I do hereby appoint my wife my sole executrix and
revoke all former wills by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal 12 April 1826 Signed sealed and published & declared
by the above named James Creel to be his last will and testament in the pre-
sence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses

and conform this to be my last will and testament and Dispose of my Es-
tate in manner following Item I Lend to my well belovd wife Mary Exum the
plantation where on I Now live as Long as she Bars my Name and my Mill with
all the proffits of hir tell my two Sons Elijah and John come of full age
and then for them to take pessession of hir and after the Death of my wife
or hir Marriage the plantation where on I Now live ^{To be} squealy devided betwen my
two sons Elijah and John with all the Rest of the Lands belonging to the
above mention plantation also my will and Desier is that the above men-
tioned Lands should be vleyd and the Rest of my children shuld have as
much of my Estate as will make them Equal with the two first Mentioned E-
lijah and John also my will and Desier is that all the Rest of my Estate
should Be Kept together tell my two sons comes of full age and then to be
Equal Devided among all my Children and I also appoint my well be Lovd
wife Mary Exum and my Brother william Exum to be Execr to this my last will
and testament and I heare by Disnul and Revoke all others wills Before by
