Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand nephows James Finkles and Samuel Finklea to each one Cow and Calf at my decease to be given to them by my Ext^{FS} to them their heirs & afsigns forever Item I give And bequeath unto my friend Richard Hutson my Rifle Gun to him his heirs & afsigns forever Item I give and bequeath unto my brother John Holland children Joseph Holland amd Rebecca Holland and to Richard Hutsons children Sarah Hutson Mariah Hutson and Joseph Hutson the half of my stock of cattle and Hoge also my stock of Horses (except two to be chosen by wife) at my death to them their Heire and afsigns forever to be divided between said children in the Same manner as is above specified and to be taken care of by their parents until they arrive to the age of twenty one years or married Alan I give and bequeath unto my said friend Richard Hutson one hundred Acres of land which it New lives
