I Jeremiah Harrelson (of South - Carolina Marion District, being very Sick and weak of Body, But of Sound mind and memory, thanks be to God for the Same, Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body, And Knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die - Do Make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament, first of all I recommend my Body/ ^{to} the earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Friends, And my Soul I recommend to God who gave it Nothing doubting but what they will be reunited at the last day - And as Touching Such worldly goods as it has pleased God to bless me with, I Give and dispose of in the following manner and form (first, I Give to my beloved wife Abigail, one Sorrel mare, three cows and one bull calf, two Sows with Pigg, and four Shoats, one feather bed and furniture, and all my household furniture, except one feather bed One Saddle and Bridle, one wheel and cards, one loom, one plow and gin one ax and hoe, Secondly I give all the rest of my Property to my lawful Heirs to be equally divided
