In the name of God Amen I Jefse Bryant of Marion District in the State of South Carolina being very weak in body but of perfect mind and memory Thanks be to God therefor calling to mind the mortality of my body and nowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my sole into hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recompend to the Earth to se buried in decent christian burial at the dispretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to blefs me with in this life I give demise and dispose of the Same in the following member & form First I give and bequeath to my baloved daughter Smithy one negro Girl named Jin. and the plantation where I now reside on Catfish Creek lso I give to my well beloved dife Mourning Briant all the remainder part of my state real and personal her lifetime and at her death my whole state to be equally divided amongs my surviving children vis Elizabeth Mertin. W Briant. Jas Briant, Jefse Briant Mary Finkles Sally Perritt Mourning Harroll Citey Perritt Milly Gasque Smithy Briant to be equally divided among them share and share alike I likewise constitute make and ordain my son Jim Briant and my soninlaw haron Martin sole Executors of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and eal this 24 of February 1818 and year of American Independence Signed Sealed published pronounced and declared by the said Jefse Briant to be and contain his lest will and testament in the presents of us who in his presence and in the presence of ach other have hereunto bulscribed our names
