I John Greavis of the State of South Carolina and District of Marion do make ordain and declare this instrument of Writing to be my last Will and Testament revoking all others. Imprimis. All my Just debts and funeral expences are to be punctually and Speidily paid and the Legaces herein after bequeathed are to be discharged as soon as circumstances will permit and in the manner directed Item to my beloved Daughter Sarah Greavis I give and bequeath a negro girl named Phillis, my black horse named Tar barrel together with one fourth part of my personal Estate to her and her issue forever Item To my beloved Daughter Susannah Greavis I give and bequeath a negro girl named Ammarilla, my bay Horse Cleland, Six Cows and Calves and one fourth part of my personal Estate to her and her Issue forever. Item To my beloved Daughter Elisabeth Greavis I give and bequeath a negro girl named Nancy, my bay Horse named Hopkins Six Cows and Calves and one fourth part of my personal Estate to her and her Issue forever. But Should either of my Daughter above named die leav<sup>ing</sup> no Issue in that case my will is that the property bequeathed to them together with the increase of Said property if any Shall be equally divided between the rest of my Children then living. And Should either of my Daughters marry and their Husbands survive them whether with or without issue in that Case my will and desire is that the Husband So Surviving Shall have no control of the property above bequeathed nor the increase of Said property if any but be subject to controle and direction of my Executors hereafter named. It is also my Will and desire that my Said Daughters Shall live and remain in my House without interruption as long as they remain Single. Item. To my beloved Son William Henry Greavis I give and bequeath four hundred Acres of Land in three Separate Tracts Joining each other on condition he pay each of his Sisters Seventy five

Dollars on their marriage, together with one fourth part of my personal Estate to him and his lawful Issue forever.

Item. The one fourth part of my personal Estate as above bequeathed to each of my Children I wish divided in the following manner the property to be divided appraised by three Judicious disinterested persons and divided amongst them by draught Lastly I constitute and appoint my loving Nephews Francis Greavis and Bennet Greavis and my Son William Henry Greavis Executors of this my last Will and testament

Witness my hand and Seal the third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eight and in the thirty Second year of the Independence of the

United States of America
