and Keep all of my property her natural life and at her death I desire that  
the property that may remain shall be equally divided between my brother  
Henry Clarkes children and the children of my wifes sister Nancy Smith  
that is to say John Smith and Nancy Smith shall have one half and the child-  
ren of my brother Henry Clark of Marlboro District shall have the other  
half It is moreover my will and desire that John J Gibson do Act as my Ex-  
ecutor with all the powers that the Laws of Executors does or may give
