Wiggins for one hundred and ten Dollars and intrist to be equally Divided betwene them four above named Children I also give and bequeath unto my son in law Edward D Eaddy the Sum of fifty Dollars to be paid to him the first day of January next to be taken out of a note of hand Signed by William Curry for Sixty Dollars and if I should not live to want the ballance ten Dollars Edward D. Eaddy to have the^{rest} of the note all the ballance of my notes of hands and Demans of money I give and bequath unto my five Children Philip Bartell William Bartell Elizabeth Greel Peter Bartell and Mary Eaddy to be collected and Devided Equally among them five Children all the remainder of my Estate that I am pussed of at my Death to be Sold and Equally Devided betwene my five Children Philip Bartell William Bartell Elizabeth Greel Peter Bartell and Mary Eaddy Share and Share alike at the same time I do appoint my two Sons Philip Bartell and William Bartell Joint Executors of this my last will and testament to which I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this ninth day of July in the year of our lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three and in the fifty Eight year of america independance.
