unto god, Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to Die do make and ordain this my Last will and
Testament: That is to say principally and first of all, I give and Recom-
mend my Soul into the Hand of almighty God that give it and my Body I Recom-
mend to the Earth to be Buried in Decent Christian burial at the Discretion
of my Executor nothing danding but at the general Resurrection, I
Shall Receive the Same again by the almighty power of God, and as touching
such worldly Estate Wherewith it hath pleased God to blefs me in this Life
give and Dispose of the Same in the following manner and form
first of all - I Constitute and I appoint my Son Donald McQueen my Execu-
tor to this my Last will and Testament— I Bequest and give to my beloved
wife Nancy McQueen all that plantation and tract of Land where I now Live
all my Stock of Cattle Sheep Hoges and my horse all my plantation & farm-
ing tools household and kitcheng furniture and my two negroes Ned and fillis
Corn pees potates Baconn Beeff all the income and profite that arises from
the Said property her Life time except three cows and two year old hiafer
and ten head of sheep I bequeath to my Daughter Margarate and there increas
after my Death I bequeath and to my Daughters Catharin McLeod Mary Marsiling
death
A Jean McDuffee the negroe Ned after the/of my beloved to be Equally De-
between
vided/them three and there Lawfull Issues at there own Discretion also
twenty Dollars my Executor is to pay to Each when Collected from Margarate,
and her increas
I bequest and give to my Daughter margarate my negroe fillis/ at the Death
of my beloved wife; which She is to pay to my Executor Sixty Dollars if
the Said negroe fillis Lives and if she Dies before she takes pofessions of
the negroe I order my Executor not to Collect from margarate the Sixty and
if the Sixty Dollars not Collected my Executor is not to pay the other hiers
they twenty Dollars Each / the Real meaning of this that Catharine McLeod
mary Marsiling & Jean McDuffee is to have no other part but the negroe boy
if the negroe Girle Dies All I bequeath to my beloved to Remain with her
her
During her Lifetime and at/Death I bequeath to my Son Donald all the prop-

erty I bequeath to my wife Except the two negroes and the ~~30~~^{four} head
of Cattle and ten head of Sheep one feather Bed and furniture I give
to my beloved wife to Dispose at her own Discretion and I do hereby utterly

Legacies bequests and Executors by me in any ways before named willed and
bequeathed ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my Last will and
testaments in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
19th day of January 1822 —
