PENELOPE MORREE

In the name of God amen I being weak in body but of disposing mine and memory I gave devise and bequeath unto my beloved Son William Morree one filly one cow and Barling two Sows and leuen Shotes one bed and firniture one Sadle and bridle one pot one half of the table firniture one hand mill one Shot Gun  $\frac{1}{2}$  and all my plantation Toolcs also I gave devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Julian morree one horse named - Shirk Sadle and bridle one bed and firniture one cow and Barling one Sow and three Shotes and the remmung half of the table firniture three two year old barrows and three other shotes also lemons wheel & cardes the Small pot and dutch oven also I lene to my daughter Mary Welch one Cow and Barling and at her death I gave Said cow an Barling to the hire of her body and all the Ballance of my estate to be Equally divided Betwene all my children thin the twenty ninth Day of June 1833
