I Robert Gregg of the State of South Carolina and District of Marion Being  
 in low State of health but in perfect Mind and memory and Calling to mind  
 the certainty of Death do wish to dispose of my temporal affaires in the  
 manner and form as following First I recommend my Soul to God who give  
 it and my Body to be buried in a christian manner by my Executors and all  
 my Just debts to be paid out of estate and funeral expences First I Give unto  
 my Beloved Wife Frances M Gragg the use of all my Estate both person-  
 ally and Real for the benefit herself and my fore Children her life time  
 or widowhood at the expiration of her death or widowhood I wis my estate  
 to be taken care of untill the youngest child comes of age and Then to be  
 equally divided among my surviving Children But should my Beloved wife  
 Frances Live or Remain a widow when the youngest come to be twenty one  
 years of age or either of then she is at Liberty to lent then as she  
 thinks best provided the property is not removed out of the state I also  
 Nominate and appoint Joseph Gregg and Levy Gregg Executors of this my Last  
 will and testament In witness whereof I do set my hand and Seal revoking  
 all former wills by me maid I do hereby acknowledge this to be my Last  
 will and testament In the Year of our Lord one
