of man, do make, constitute and ordain this to be my last will and testa-  
ment in manner and form following, (Viz) after my decease I request my  
body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Exe<sup>rs</sup> - and all my Just  
debts to be paid

Item. I give and bequeath unto my Neice Eliza Cooper, one negro girl of  
such size and discription as can be purchased for two hundred and fifty  
dollars which am<sup>t</sup>. I request to be applyed to the said purpose by my Nep-  
hew Samuel Cooper, who I request to act as guardian for my said Neice Eliza  
Cooper, to her and to the issue of her body -----

Item. I give and bequeath to my neice Susannah E Wilson, my grey horse  
sulkey and harness to her, her heirs and assigns forever -----

Item. I give and bequeath to my friend Alex<sup>r</sup> L. Gregg my silvr watch, to him  
his heirs and assigns forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah ann D Wilson all the remain-  
ing part of my Estate which I may die possesed of (except my wearing ap-  
parel to my brother Joseph Wilson) to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

It is my request, should it meet the approbation of my brother Hugh Wilson,  
that he shall give and make over to my said daughter Sarahann D Wilson and  
to the issue of her body the negro woman Kate and her Children. And lastly,  
I do nominate, constitute, and appoint my Son in law Samuel E Wilson, and my  
nephew Samuel Cooper, Executors of this my last will and testament, revo-  
king and making void all other wills by me heretofore made, and acknowledg-  
ing this and no other to be my last will and testament. In witness where-  
of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of Nov<sup>r</sup>, in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty, and fifty fifth  
year of American independence. -----
