But Should he leave no heirs lawfully begotten of his body at the time of his Death then and in that Case I Give all of the above mentioned land to my Five Youngest Children Share and Share alike to them there heirs and assigns forever Also I Give to my Son Jonas Baley one Feather bed and Furniture Together with my Shot Gun to him his heirs and assigns forever. Also I lend unto my Wife Patience Baley during her life time or Widowhood the ballance of my Land Together with all of my personal property that my be remaing after my Just debts be paid. and at her death or marriage to be Equally Divided between my Five Youngest children Share and Share alike to them their Heirs and assigns forever.

Also I Give to my Sons Coulson Baley James Baley and my Daughter Sarah Dees one Dollar Each to be paid by Executrix I do hereby Constitute and appoint my Wife Patience Baley Sole Executrix of this my last will and testament in witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this the 2nd day of April 1838
