

WILLIAM BETHEA

In the name of God amen I William Bethea of the State of South Carolina
Marion District being of sound disposing mind and memory and knowing
die (in body) do make and ordain this Instrument in writing to be and rat-
tained by last will and testament revoking all others by me made and rat-
tained as my last will and testament and this only in the words following viz I
body first it is my will that after my death my body be buried in a civilized
manner at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter mentioned And as to a
worldly goods which God has given me this is my will and I give and bequeath
Item as follows My will is that my Executors hereinafter named do collect as
soon as possible all dues to me or my Estate and that they (Executors) do
apply the aforesaid dues when collected to the payment of all my just debts
(and if there be not enough to satisfy them (my just debts) as aforesaid then
my will is that they pay them out of the property which I may have unnoticed
in this my last will and testament as the law direct after such
the dues to me or my Estate be more than sufficient to satisfy my debts my
will is that my will Executors do give the remainder of my dues after such
collection and disbursement as aforesaid to my beloved widow Mary Bethea for
the support of the family living with her at my death to be applied by her
(my widow) according to her discretion— I give and bequeath to my beloved
Son son Levi Bethea a tract or parcel of land containing six hundred and thirty
Land is part of a tract surveyed for James Gladney Sept 2nd 1782 for 300 acres
1799 the above tract I now give to my son Levi begins on a Cypress Stake
111x from thence (the above named Cypress Stake 111x on Buck Stump run)
running N E 70° 30' 4" to Stake 111x. thence N E 82° 12' 10" to pine 3x0
thence near the road to pine Stump 3x0 thence S E 59° 41' 0" to Stake and pine 3x0
thence S W 15° 28' 0" to pine 3x0 a pr. run of Buck Stump thence along said Run
to the beginning further reference to this tract may be made to a Plat &
Certificate made by John Harlee on the first day of December 1829 and marked
N E 1 further give to my son Levi a right to turn his Stock in my pasture

the lands thereof being given to my other Legatees as may hereinafter be
nominated but my son Levi for this privilege shall be bound to keep the pasture
fence in good repair which is in the lower part of said pasture But should
my son Levi ever sell this land given above/ the right he has to the pas-
ture after such sale shall (by such sale) be forfeited and shall not be en-
joyed by the purchaser this privilege shall be to him (Levi) and the heirs
of his body so long as they retain possession of the above given land. And
my will is that my Son Levi Bethen shall have after my decease the following
negro slaves viz Jenny & Dinch her child and Isaac which Slaves he has had
and may now have in his possession And if my beloved son should die without
lawfull begotten children then and in that case my will is that the above
named negroes and their increase be equally divided between his surviving
brothers (my sons) or the heirs of there bodies lawfully begotten but if
my son Levi shall live the above named negroes viz Jenny and her daughter
and Isaac above named shall belong to Levi and the heirs of his body law-
full begotten I give and bequeath to my son William Bethen the following
4th tract of land found by survey to contain Eight hundred and forty three ac-
res being part of several tracts of land as will more fully appear by a
reference to a plot made by John Harlee first Dec^{br} 1829 and marked No 4.
Said land beginning S oak pr Run of big Reedy Creek thence running N E

And I also bequeath to my son William the following negro Slaves viz Mole
Slaves Edmund and Peter and my will is that said negroes to son William shall
be according to my will in reference to the Slaves given to my son Levi
with the same provisions my will is that my son William shall have after
my decease One feather bed and furniture necessary

Item 3 I give and bequeath to my beloved son Francis Bethen all that tract con-
taining (by survey) Five hundred and Seven acres being part of several
tracts of land as will more fully appear by a reference to a Certified
plot made by John Harlee 1st Decr 1829 and marked No 5 Said land beginning
on a Gum 3x on main run of Buck Swamp runs from thence N E 42^d 8^h to a

visions as made in case of slaves given to my son Levi in this my last will

with their calves and also one feather and furniture. I do give and be-
queath to my dear son Avander all the lower part of land described in
7 gift to my son James in the part marked item Sixth son James letting James
lower line which I made and described be Avanders upper line containing
land in this lower part as I Judge Five hundred and fifty acres. and if he Avan-
der die without lawfully begotten child or children the land in this be-
quest shall go to James and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten provi-

Also I give and bequeath to my son Avander after my decease the following
Slaves negroes via Het Jeph and Charity these last named slaves to be subject to
the same provisions as slaves given to my son Levi And also one yoke of
Steers Two Cows with their calves and one feather Bed & furniture. I give
Item to my son John C (besides land deeded to him) the following tract of land

of the Little PeeDee River on Big Reedy Creek begining with 2 Gums in run of

1 Decr 1829 marked No 1 Also I give to my beloved son John C one Slave via
Slave Sophy subject to the same provisions as with my gift to Levi my son Also
Item one bed and furniture I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca the fellow-
rebecca ing negroes Slaves via Nan Cloe and Harry and if my beloved daughter Rebecca
die without lawfully begotten children these negroes last named Shall be
equally divided between her surviving Sisters my daughter but if she lives
these negroes shall belong to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begot-
ten also I give to my daughter two cows and their calves One Bed and furni-
ture I also give to my daughter Rebecca as above named. I give and bequeath
Item to my daughter Apley Campbell the following negroes slaves via Grace. Jacob

A.Campbell and Dinah these last named negroes shall be under the same provision as
Item 11th those given to my daughter Rebecca. I will and bequeath to my daughter Mary
M. Bether Bether the following negroes via Het Stephen and Hupy these negroes to be

under the same provision as those given to my daughter Rebecca. After my Item death I will and bequeath to my daughter Catherine the following negroes 12 Kath- to be under the same provisions as made and provided in case of the negroes given to my daughter Rebecca viz Hannah Bob and Alick and I also give to my daughter Catherine two Cows and their calves Also One Bed and furniture

Item 13 I will and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah Ann Bethea the following negroes(Subject to the same provisions as the negroes given to my daughter Rebecca viz Little Jack Aley and Peggy also I give to my daughter Sarah Ann Two Cows and their calves with a Bed and furniture

Item 14 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary the use of the House in which life I now live and all the plantation tools Blacksmith Shop household and Kitchen furniture plantation of land in conjunction with my sons Francis James and Evander on which the house stand Also the use of the negre man Was till my brother Elisha death and also the use of the forllowing negroes widow for and during the term of her life or widowhood Viz Jack Nero Sam Rachel Lucy Simon & Daniel and at her death or expiration of her widowhood the

Item 15 last named negro Shall go to my children as follows Viz Simon I then will Francis and bequeath to my son Francis Nero to my son Evander Daniel to my son James Jones and the rest with all their increase shall be equally divided among all my children share and share alike and subject to the same provisions made in my separate and specified gifts to each under their respective Items

Item 16 And I further will that the increase from this day the (third day of July Increase one thousand Eight hundred and thirty eight) born born shall to the one Negroes to whom I have as above bequeathed and willed them

Item 17 I will also ~~if my friends~~ If there be found at my death ~~my~~ money in my Money p[er]f[ec]tion it shall belong to my wife Mary also my single horse carriage carriage and also all my stock of sheep and cattle for the use of all the family cattle who shall live with her and remain on this plantation for James Evander Horses and Francis Horses to be disposed of in the same way excepting those which may have been given in a former part of this my will which exceptions is in cattle and oxen and steers hege will go as the cattle

Item 18 And all' that may not be noticed or Specifically above must at my death unspecified be equally divided among my children share and share alike my property

Item 19 And I do hereby nominate my well beloved sons John Bethea, Levi Bethea, William Bethea, & Francis Bethea Executors to this last Will and Testament hereby revoking and Nullifying all former Wills made by me and establishing and confirming this to be and contain my last Will and testament as aforesaid In Witness whereof I the said William Bethea of as aforesaid do sign my name and affix my Seal in the presence of us who at his request and in the presence of each other do sign our names as witnesses of and to the same this, the fourth day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty eight and in the Sixty Second year of the Independence of the United States of America Th above is interlined twice at 15 line from the beginning "To" next 17 from bottom of first side Red Bay
