I Alexander McRae of the District of Marlborough and State of South Carolina being weak in Body, but of Sound and perfect mind and memory Blessed be Almighty God for the Same - do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) First, I give and bequeath unto my Beloved Wife Catherine McRae one third part of all my personal property also with the privilege and use of my Dwelling house and out houses and So much of my ~~personal property~~ as she may wish to Cultivate for her maintenance during her life or pleasure, also one Bed and furniture for her Share of the Beds and furniture. The other two thirds of my personal property to be Equally Divided among my three Daughters Isabella, Margaret, and Mary McRae, I do also give and Bequeath unto my Son Roderick McRae the whole of my Real Estate with the Exception above made to my wife Catherine McRae for her maintenance during her life. I also hereby appoint Roderick McRae Sen. and Christopher McRae Sole Executors of this my last will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fourth day of November in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and twenty four.
