Amen. Blessed be God. I give my body to the Earth from whence it was taken ~~in full appearance~~ ^{in full assurance} of its resurrection from thence at the last day, as for my burial I desire it may be decent; at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, as for my worldly Estate I will and positively order that all my debts be paid. Also I do give and demise unto my brother Samuel Pouncey four sons namely, William, Henry, Anthony, Thomas and James. All that I possess in lands, credits, goods of any kind, Bonds notes or Book accounts or any other thing or things whatsoever to be equally divided amongst the four boys and in case of the decease of any of them, before they have lawful issue that then and in that case, the whole to be divided between the surviving part of the boys, and do constitute my trusty friend Nathaniel Sanders Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and trustee for the children before mentioned
