Mind and Memory do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following, that is to say.

Primit. I Will that all my debts and funeral charges be
paid and discharged by my Executors herein after named;

Item, I give and bequeath unto my Brother Samuel four Sons
Viz. William, Henry, Anthony, James Nathaniel Pouncey all
my Estate both Real and personal to be equally divided to to
them as they come of Age. And for the Executors to do with
the Estate as they shall think best for the improvement of
the same till the Heirs comes of Age to Receive it, and for
it to be kept to-gether until then. Except there shuld be a
part required to pay for the Heirs Schooling----

Lastly, I do make and Constitute Muggus Oorgill And Nathaniel
Sanders Both of Pee Dee Cheraw District And Richard Bryant of
the Saltcatchers, Charles Town District, Executors of this
my last Will and Testament. In witness Whereof I have
hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 2nd day of June--- in the
Year of our Lord 1788
