ARCHIBALD COLQUHOUN

The Last Will and Testament of Archibald Colquhoun of Marlborough District, South Carolina.

In the name of God Amen I Archibald Colquhoun of State and District aforesaid, being very weak and sick in health of body, and of perfect mind and Memory, thanks be to God, Calling into Mind the mortality of my body. Do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament In manner and form following: First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Catherine Colquhoun, my Dwelling house and a sufficient support of my plantation during her life. Second, I give and bequeath unto my three Sons John Colquhoun and Alexander Colquhoun & Duncan Colquhoun A certain tract of land containing one hundred and thirty-five acres, be the same more or less, to them and their heirs to be equally divided betwixt them--- and Also my stock of Cattle and hogs, to be equally divided betwixt the aforesaid John & Alexander & Duncan Colquhoun and I direct and my Will is that all my Just debts be paid.

Also, I constitute make and ordaint John Colquhoun and Alexander Colquhoun my sole Executors of this my last will and testament I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments, wills, legacies, bequests, and Executors, by me an anywise before named, willed and bequeathed. Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witnefs Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal, this Second day of August One thousand eight hundred and Twenty eight.
