I do devise and dispose of in the manner in the manner and form following that is to say. Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother Hardy Stewart, Stewart, Three hundred dollars to be raised and paid to him his heirs & assigns by my Executors, immediately after the decease of my wife. -

Thirdly. I give and devise unto my beloved Sister Elizabeth Harlee her heirs and assigns the Sum of three Hundred Dollars to be also raised & paid out of my Estate and paid by my Executors immediately after the decease of my wife.

Fourthly. I give and devise unto my Nephew Thomas Cottingham his heirs the sum of ten dollars to be raised out of my Estate & paid by Executors immediately after the decease of my wife. -

Fiftly, I give and devise unto my nephew Jonathan Cottingham his heirs & assigns the sum of Forty dollars to be raised and paid in the same manner and form as the above mentioned legacies.

Sixthly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Setia Stewart all the land & premises, including the House & plantation where I now reside which is estimated at eighteen hundred acres, together with all the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate which is not heretofore with disposed of, of every description both

personal and real, including money and my stock of Horses
Cattle hogs. Sheep and farming utensils, household & kit-
chen furniture of every description for her to dispose of.
at her own discretion & Lastly I do hereby nominate const-
itute and appoint her my said Wife Celia Stewart Sole Exe-
cutrix and Nathan Thomas Esquire & Capn. Hugh McLaurin, and
Daniel McIntyre Executors of this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking & makeing void all and every other will & wills
at any time heretofore by me and do declare this to be my last
will & Testament.

the word "of" erased, the word "con-
stitute" & appoint" enterlined and the
word "myself" erased before signed.
