In the Name of God Amen - I Donald Stewart of State of South Carolina & district of Marlborough being very sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God, Calling to mind Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say, & first of all I give and recommend my Soul to God that gave it and my Body I recommend to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to blefs me in this life I give demise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form Imprimis, I give & bequeath to my loving wife Isabel Stewart after my Just debts are paid whom I likewise with household Goods Debts & movable Effects I appoint my wife whom I appoint & ordain the Sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament, all & Singular my lands messuages & Tenements by her possed & enjoyed.
