I Edmund Brown of Marlborough District in the State of South Carolina planter being now sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory and understanding Thanks be to God and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament---- First I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it not doubting but I shall receive the same again By his mighty power and as to such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to blese me with in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the manner and form following, That is to say

Item. first I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy Brown Two feather beds and furniture and all my household and kitchen furniture one gelding horse three cows and three head of young cattle twenty head of hogs and five head of sheep for her to dispose of as she thinks best during her life time.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved sons Jesse Brown Edmund Brown James Brown & Henry Brown five shillings Sterling Each to be paid to them by my Executors.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughters Selah James Sally Parker Nancy Pate and Charlotte Graham Each the sum of five shillings Sterling to be paid to them by my Executors.--

And I do nominate and apoint my beloved and Trusty friends John Graham & Edmund Brown Executors to this my last Will & Testament revoking and making void all former wills and Testaments by me made and do declare this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Thirteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one.
