I, Giles Newton of Marlborough District in the State of South Carolina Planter, being of sound health of body, and sound and disposing mind, Memory and understanding, Praised be the Ruler of the Universe for one same, do make this my last will in manner following;-- I desire that when it pleaseth Almighty God to Call me from this Transitory life that my body may be decently buried in a Christian like manner, at the discretion of my loving wife & my Executors hereafter named.-----

First, it is my will and desire that all my just debts Shall be fully paid and discharged,-- I do lend unto my beloved wife Betty Newton For and during the term of her Natural life, The Plantation whereon I now live with all my lands thereunto appertaining with the Improvements thereon, all my household & Kitchen furniture, all my stock of every kind, & the use and Labour of the Negroes Slaves following. ((this is to say) Old Peter, old Pender, Young Peter, Nutt, Gate, Ralph Ephraim & Charlotte.

I do give and bequeath unto my loving daughter Martha Bullard Two Negroe Boys Slaves named Dick & Sam, to her & her heirs forever.-----

Also, I do give & bequeath unto my loving Daughter Ann Hern- den One Negroe woman named Fortune and her boy child named Jerrey, with her Increase to her & her heirs forever.-----

Also, I do give and bequeath unto my loving Son Younger Newton at the decease of my loving wife One Negroe Boy named & Called Young Peter to him & his heirs forever.

Also, I do give devise and bequeath unto my loving Son James Newton, one Negroe Girl named Clary, with her increase, and at the decease of my loving wife, all the Lands with the Improve- ments thereon that I may die possessed of and Two Negroes,

Old Peter & Pender, To him & his heirs forever.

Also, I do give & bequeath unto my loving daughter Elizabeth Summerall one Negroe Boy named Billey, and one negroe Girl named Milley with her Increase, to her & her heirs forever.

Also, I do give & bequeath unto my three daughters Marthe Bullard, Anne Herndon, & Elizabeth Summerall at the decease of my loving wife the following Slaves (viz), Nutt, Cate, Ralph, Ephraim & Charlotte with their Increase to be equally divided between them Share and Share alike to them & their heirs forever.

Also, I do give & bequeath unto my Grand daughter, Betty Portwood Two hundred dollars if she doth live & attain to the age of Twenty one Years ( but not Otherwise) to be raised out of the Stock lent to my loving wife & to be paid to her by my Executors when She shall arrive at the age of Twenty one Years.

Also, I do give & bequeath at the death of my loving wife, to be equally divided among all my children all the rest residue and remainder of my personal estate of what nature or kindsover not herein before particularly divided.-----

And Lastly, I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Loving Son Younger Newton & my Son in Law Benjamin Herndon Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby Revokeing and making void all and every other Will and Wills at any time heretofore by me made and do declare this to be my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand & Seal this 31 day of March One thousand Eight hundred & four.-----
