in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred & Eighteen Witnesseth--

in the way and manner herein after mentioned----

Item 1st.. That is to Say. I Give unto my Wife Sarah Hodges
all my household and Kitchen furniture my Riding Chair &
Harnes my Sorrel Horse known by the name of Sorry & the
one half of my Stock of Cattles..

Item 2nd.. I Give unto my Nephew Willaim Samuel Whitfield
Son of George B. Whitfield four negroes as follows Santee,
Bill, Offner, & Peter to him and his heirs forever---

Item 3rd.. I Give unto my Neice Emelia Elizabeth Whitfield
daughter of the aforesaid George B. Whitfield. Three negroes
as follows, Hannah, July, & Solomon, to her and her heirs
forever....

Item 4th.. I Give unto my Step Father William Whitfield my
little Baul Horse and Sorrel Colt for the use & behoof of the
Said Wm. Whitfield forever..

Item 5th.. I Give unto my half brother George B. Whitfield
the other half of my Stock of Cattle all my Stock of Hogs my Rifle
gun, my Black Baul Horse, my Bay Mare and it is my desire that
the Said George B. Witifield Should receive all debts due me
& appropriate them to payment of my debts and that he the Said
George B. Whitfield do make sale of all my Surplus Corn and
other property not mentioned aforesaid for the payment of my
Debts and if there Should Remain nay money after the aforesaid
payments I give it unto the aforesaid George B. Whitfield
with the aforesaid propertyt in this Item for his use for-
ever.-----

Item 6th It is furthermore my deisre that Geo. B. Whitfield
James R. Ervin & R. Carlofs should be my Executors & that all
the aforesaid Items be carried into effect.
