

In the name of God, Amen, I Isaac Neavel of South Carolina Marlborough County, being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory and calling unto mind the mortality of the body and knowing that it is appointed all men once to die, do make and constitute this my last will and testament and the first place I resign my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it, And I commit my body to the earth to be decently entered at the discretion of my executors in hopes of a glorious Resurrection and for those worldly goods which it hath pleased God to endow me with, I gave and bequeath in manner and form following.

Item. I gave and bequeath unto my son William Neavel the plantation I now live ^{on} it being two tracts, one fifty acre tract granted to Thomas Wolley and a hundred and fifty acre tract granted to Malachi Marfe Also four tracts lying in Screvens neck two tracts granted to John Abram one tract I think containing thirty Seven and a half acres and one containing one hundred and fifty acres and two tracts granted to myself one containing I think four hundred and ten acres Also a tract containing one hundred and twenty Acres Also a tract lying upon the hunny ford containing eight hundred Acres Also a tract lying partly in the pecoson and Joining Nathaniel Whittington land containing I think between three ~~and~~ four hundred acres more or less Also one hundred acres that Nancy Lewis lives upon granted to me, Also one small tract lying on the Marsh Creek Joining Thomas Bentons land also one fifty acre tract Joining Charles Johnstons land, To have and to hold to him and his heirs forever-----

Item. I give and bequeath unto my son George Neavel the sum of ten shillings to be paid out of my Estate by my executors it being the last part of his portion.---

Item. I gave and bequeath unto my grandson Thomas Perkins

when he shall arrive at the age of twenty one years the sum of ten shillings to be paid by my executors it being the last part of his portion and it being the last part of Martha Perkins deceased their portion.

Item. I gave and bequeath unto my son William Neavel one negro wench named Feeba and one negro girl named grace and a negro named Bel and one negro Girl named Hannah and one small girl^{child} named Till and another small girl named Rose and negro fellow named Ben and one small boy child named Ben with all and Singular the rest of my Estate Rayel and Personal. Lastly. I do nominate and appoint my sone William Neavel to be my lawful Executor ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament.-----
