and District being weak in Body but of Sound and Disposing Mind & Memory thanks be to God for the Same & Calling to Mind that it is appointed for all Men once to Die do make the following to be my laste Will & Testament.

First I Recomend My Soul to Almighty God that Gave it & After My Death My Body to be Caried in a Christian like manner at the Discretion of My Executors.

And as to What Worldly property it hath been Please God to blefs Me With I Dispose of in the following Manor (To Wit) I Give & bequeath to my Beloved Wife Manning Ivey three Cows & Calves which She has now in her posefsion & All My Household furniture to be at her own Disposal I also lend My S. Wife During her Natural life three negroes (To Witt) one Negro Woman Named Frank & at my Wifes Death I give her & her increase if any to my Son Megirts Ivy I also lend My Wife one Negro Man Named Bob and one negro boy named Santee to her During her Natural life & at her Death I give Said Bob & Santee to my Son Curtifs Ivy.

I give & bequeath to My Son Megert Ivy the following Negroes On the following terms (To Witt) A Negro Man by the Name of Nelson one Negro Woman named Sarah & three children Named Eleador & a boy Named Milton ~~Frank~~ thett increase if any and also a negro Woman Named Frank at his Mothers Death to him his heirs & Afsigne for Ever on these terms My Son Margaret Ivy Shall at his Mothers Death Pay to my daughter Mary Hersey one Hundred Dollars And to pay Isaiah Ivy My Son at his Mothers Death one Hundred Dollars & & he My Son Megert to pay my Son Micaiah Ivy one Hundred Dollars & to pay my Grandson James Proctor fifty Dollars all Which Payments to be made at my Wifes Death.

I give & bequeath to my Son Curtis Ivy the following Negroes on the following Terms I Give Curtis Ivy one Negro Woman Named Dinah & her increase if any to him & his heirs & Assigns forever I also Give to my Son Curtis Ivy After his Mothers Death one Negro Man Named Bob & one Negro boy named Santee on the following Terms My Son Curtis Ivy after his Mothers Death Shall pay to My My Son Joseph Ivy one hundred Dollars and My Son Curtis Ivy. Shall pay to My Daughter Sarah Blake-well one Hundred Dollars also to pay to My Son James Ivy one Hundred Dollars also to pay Curtis Proctor My Gfandson Fifty Dollars all the S. payments to be made at his Mothers Death And Lastly I nominate & Appoint My beloved Sons Megert Ivy & Curtis Ivy to Be My Executors of this My last Will & Testament I likewise Revoke & Disannull all Other Wills & Gifts by Me heretofore Made & do hereby Ratify & Pronounce this to be my last Will & Testament in Witnefs Where of I have here-unto Set My hand & Seal this 25th Day of July in the year of our Lord 1820 and in the forty fifth year of the Independ-ence of the United States of America
