

In the Name of God, Amen, I Jesse Council, of the State of South Carolina Marlborough County, Being weak in Body, but of Perfect Mind and Memory, thanks be Given unto God, Calling unto Mind the Mortality of My Body, and Knowing that it is Appointed for all Men Once to die, do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament, that ~~it to say~~, Principally once first of All I give and Recommend my Soul into the Hand of the Almighty God, that Gave it, and my Body I Recommend to the Earth, to be buried in Decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Executors, Nothing doubting but at the General

Resurrection I shall receive the Same Again; by the Mighty Power of God.-- And Touching Such Worldly Estate Wherewith it has pleased God to blesse in this life. I give Demise, once Dispose of the Same in the following manner and form-- First I Give and Bequeath to John Ferrel My half Brother All my Lands Lying on both Sides of Pee Dee River, one Negro fellow Named Carolina, one Negro woman Named Silva one other Negro Woman Named Amy, one Negro Boy Named Tom, one other Boy Named Peter, Together with All my Stock of Horses and Pigs.

Item I Give and Bequeath to Gincey Feilds my half Sister one Negro Girl by name of Sarah-----

Item I Give and Bequeath to James Feilds My Half Brother one Negro Girl by name of Del, one Negro Boy Named Harry. Item I Lend to my Mother Elizabeth Feilds During her Life All the Rest of my property and at her Death I give and Bequeath the Property to her Lent. To John Ferrel Gincey Feilds and James Feilds to be Equally Divided Between Them--- And I Do Hereby Appoint my Uncle William Pledger and my Brother John Ferrel my Executors and I do Hereby Utterly Disallow Revoke, and Disannul all and Every other former Testament Wills Leagues, Bequeaths and Executors by me in Any Will before named, Willed and Bequeathed. Ratifying and confirming this, and no other, to be my last Will and Testament I Witness Whereof I have therunto set my Hand and Seal this tenth Day of July in the

year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Two, and in
the Twenty Seventh year of the Independence of America.
