District and sell the said land & Mills or return back the said title to him the said Mendenhall without having it recorded in the public registers office if so John Mendenhall will do me the favour to take Said land again which favour I request if he can make it convenient & suit himself thereby. and if not my will & desire is that my executors hereafter named will sell the whole of the Said land for the purpose of raising Money to make payment to Said Mendenhall for the same or otherwise if it should Suit my executors or any or either of them to take the land and to pay the price that they do so, as I consider it will be out of my wife's power to keep the posession of the land and to raise the money to discharge the debt due for the same.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Macy the use and profit of all the residue of my Estate of every name & nature during her widowhood to be applied to the raising and education of my children & if in case she should marry my will is that remains of my Estate to be divided share and share alike between my wife and children. And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my dearly beloved wife Mary Macy and my trusty friend William Way of Marlborough District & George Swain of Guilford County North Carolina my Executrix and Executors of this my last will Testament.
