I give to my son Joseph McDaniel a certain negro girl named I give to my son Alexander McDaniel a certain Negro woman named Phillis reserving at the same time the first child which the sai

years of age to my daughter Sarah Duke, I also give to my wife Saran McDaniel (after all my just debts are paid) all my Stock of all kinds with all my woods debts and moveble effects whatsoever until my son John Standard McDaniel shall arrive to the age of twenty one years; at which time, my will is that the whole of the afore mentioned property, be divided into two equal divisions the one half to be and remain in the possession of my wife Sarah McDaniel for and during the term of her Natural life and after her decease to revert to my JohnStandard McDaniel. I also give unto my two daughters Sarah Duke & Ann Fuller Stubbs the remaining half of my house hold furniture to be equally divided between them. I also give to my three sons James, Joseph and Alexander Mc * Daniel all the remaining half of my stock and movable effects which has not been before given away to be equally divided between them; and in case the said John Standard McDaniel shall die before he shall arrive at the age of twenty one years of age all his property shall be equally divided between my living children after the decease of his mother, and I do hereby constitute make and ordain my wife Barah Mc-Daniel Executrix and James, Joseph and Alexander McDaniel Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills Legacies bequests and executors by me in anywise before named Willes & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
