I Leavy Quick of State of South Carolina and County of Marlborough being sick in body but of good and sound memory thanks be to Almighty and Calling to Remembrance the uncertain Estate of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield to death whenever it shall please God to Call, do make Constitit ordain and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following Revokeing and annulling by these presents all and Every testament or testaments will or wills heretofore by me made and declare Either by words or writings and this is to be taken only for my last will and testament and here unto set my hand and seal in the---of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and two, September the 9 day. My deserts to bestow upon me I do order and give and dispose The Same in manner and form following that is to say first, I will that all these debts and dues as I owe in Right or Conscience to any manner of person or persons Whatsoever and then my moveable Estate and on Moveable Shall be Equally divided between my wife and foure Children Sary Quick Henry Quick Benjamin quick Leavy quick Sandy quick That So long as my wife Should keeps Estate together and if not to be put into the hands of the Executors for the use of them same Children Thomas quick Quillar quick
