In witness whereof I the said Margaret Colquhoun have hereunto Set my hand and Seal the twenty second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five. Signed Sealed, declared and published by the above named Margaret Colquhoun as and for her last will & her Testament in the presence of us who at her request & in her presence have subscribed our names as witness thereto.
